



Grants totaling \$48,558.90 supported reading, writing, math, science technology and the arts in 2016-17 school year. The largest grant was for \$6000.00 for Pinecrest for a complete set of multicultural and diverse leaner books for all Pinecrest classrooms. Grants funded S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) related programs and activities. The miscellaneous grant amount on the graph was for the purchase of flexible seating/standing desks.
